- MSLC Talks! panel on the 1st and 3rd Tuesdays at 7:15 PM. To date, there have been 10 of these live panels. We will offer a MSLC Talks (with kids) special if there is a 5th Tuesday. The first MSLC Talks with Kids will be this month.
- Women Wednesday panel on the 2nd Wednesday at 7:15 PM. To date, there have been 6 of these live panels.
- Bible Quest study on Sunday evenings at 7:15 PM. To date, there have been 10 of these pre-recorded panels.
- Staff Offerings: Hymn Study with Ed Tompkins (Thurs at 7:15 PM), Coffee with PJ (10 AM on Thurs), Faith Formation with Deacon Wendy. We will continue to assist the staff as needed with these offerings.

Church Mouse Program: Brooke Swartz is taking the lead in communication and organization. Five 'mice' have been identified and matched with five parties in need of a bit of a 'pick-me-up'. These pairing are anonymous and will not appear in the minutes or council reports.
